# **Watch out for Resale Companies**

The timeshare industry continues to be plagued by various "Relief and Rescue" companies and "Vacation Clubs" making various promises to reduce or eliminate maintenance fees or to assist owners in exiting from their timeshare ownership. Sadly, many owners continue to fall victim to these companies — often losing thousands of dollars while continuing to be responsible for past and potentially future maintenance fees.

Please be advised that MROP has not authorized any company to contact you regarding reducing or eliminating your maintenance fees, renting out your timeshare, or helping you exit from your MROP ownership. Please exercise extreme caution in all dealings with any third party company that contacts you regarding your MROP ownership. You should be skeptical of any company that makes such representations.

Remembering the following rules will help you determine whether you should engage with a resale company.

Rule #1 - Get it in Writing

Rule #2 - Do Your Homework

Rule #3 - Beware of Deceptive Comments

Question: What is the best time to schedule your vacation? When should I call Reservations to go where I want to go?

Answer: Know when to schedule. There's an old saying, "When you snooze, you lose!" In order to maximize your satisfaction with your membership, you need to schedule as early as possible, then plan around your vacation.

Scheduling windows are the key to planning your vacations. Your MROP membership allows you to travel to over 50 resort destinations. Availability at some resorts can be limited due to high demand in order to allow all members the opportunity to utilize the high demand resort destinations. Reservations can be made during business hours Monday through Friday from  $6~\mbox{AM}$  to  $6~\mbox{PM}$  Pacific Time and Saturday from  $8{:}30~\mbox{PM}$  to  $4{:}00~\mbox{PM}$  Pacific Time.

Scheduling can be confusing. After you've read the following, please feel free to call our reservations specialist to help further answer your questions.

#### Standard - 18 Months in advance

The Standard Scheduling window is 18 months in advance for current year credit, meaning that you can schedule your vacation 18 months prior to your desired vacation date. The scheduling windows are set up to open the entire month that is 18 months in advance on the first (1st) business day of each month. You can schedule 18 months out from a date within the current calendar year.

Example: If you wanted to go to Bear Lake, Utah in the June of 2018 you should call reservations on December 1, 2016.

#### Previous Year Credit - 16 Months in advance

Members are allowed up to two years to utilize their weeks. Current year scheduling IE 2016 week is given the 18-month scheduling window. Previous year's credit IE 2015 week is given a 16-month scheduling window. You have until the end of the calendar year to utilize the 18-month window.

Example: If you wanted to use your 2017 week to vacation in June of 2018 you would need to call reservations on February 1, 2017.

#### High Demand - 9 Months in advance for consecutive visits to same resort

The most popular MROP Vacation destinations are Hawaii and southern California beach locations. Because of the popularity and limited weeks at these destinations, the MROP Board has created a policy -- High Demand scheduling window, to allow all members a fair opportunity to go to these destinations. The policy states that if you book a reservation at any of our resorts in Hawaii and southern California beach locations in one year, then in the next year you will only be eligible to book that same location 9 months prior to the date you want

Example: If you were to go to See the Sea in San Diego in 2016, you would need to wait until your 2018 week to schedule using Standard Scheduling Window of 18 months to go back to See the Sea. Between your trip in 2016 and 2018 you can utilize the standard scheduling windows to schedule your 2017 week at any other High Demand location or you may call at 9 months to go back to See the

#### **Bonus Time**

Bonus Time is time above and beyond your normal use time which can be booked at a discounted rental rate. Bonus time is designed to fill off season weeks. Note Bonus time is subject to availability.

#### Rates

- Continental US \$38/night\*+ scheduling fee + tax.
- Hawaii & Mexico \$48/night\* + scheduling fee + tax.

#### **Bonus Time Scheduling Window**

- Continental US 21 days or less prior to the reservation date.
- · Hawaii & Mexico 42 days or less prior to the reservation date.

#### **Reading the Scheduling Windows**

On the Scheduling Windows Chart, you will find your desired vacation month and year on the far left column, this will be the row that will tell you every date that the scheduling windows will open for that month and year. You should find the scheduling window which applies to you, the column headings will be the top row of the chart. Where the row and column comes together will be when you need to call reservations to schedule your vacation

**Example:** If you wanted to go to Florida in the June of 2018. You will find June 2018 on the left hand side, and go over until you are in the Standard Scheduling window date December 1, 2016.

NOTE: We would suggest that you look at your schedule and plan your vacations as far in advance as possible. Inventory of weeks is based on a first come first served basis. If you are planning on going to go to any high demand locations we recommend calling to schedule your time 18 months in advance. Our most popular vacation destinations aet booked auickly.

## **MROP Key Terms**

#### **Color Blind**

All weeks become color blind, in the short notice timeframe; i.e. any week of any color value may be used to book any available reservation. The short notice timeframe is 28 days prior to the scheduled date of arrival for resorts inside the Continental U.S. and up to 49 days prior for resorts in Hawaii. Currently Mexico is color blind at all times.

#### **Bonus Time**

Additional time used above and beyond your week of membership for a discounted rental rate. Bonus Time is designed to use off season inventory and mid-week space at MROP Resorts. It is very rare for Bonus Time to be available during prime seasons or at high demand locations.

#### **Depositing**

The process of booking a week and then submitting it to an Exchange system for use at a future date. Banking and Depositing are used interchangeably. To check the status of a deposited or banked week you will need to contact the exchange company where you deposited it.
